

## Information - To Sell in the Boutique

Saskatoon Guild Boutique is the booth at the show where members can sell their

### Hand crafted items.

- Each Seller must be a member of the Saskatoon Quilters' Guild Inc.
- Each Seller must have a number and **use the price tag form provided**. See separate instruction sheet.
- Items must be hand/machine crafted, not store purchased.
- Items **MUST** be **new** and not used or second-hand items. Items smelling of cigarette/cannabis smoke or covered in pet hair will not be displayed for purchase.
- Seller may attach their name and contact information on the back of the item for sale. Be sure it is a separate tag as the price tag will be removed at time of sale.
- Items must be made by the member, OR a part of the member's IMMEDIATE family. If the item is made by the family member, it must be craft related, e.g. Wooden quilter's frame.
- No fabric yardage, kits, patterns or any item that would compete with the quilt shop vendors that have booths in the show will be allowed.
- Preferred items are those made for home/personal use e.g. – runners, quilts, wearables, knit, crochet, bags, baskets, ornaments, wall hangings, etc. No hard surface art such as canvas painted surfaces unless quilt related are allowed
  - IF you have any questions whether the unique items you have made or are planning to craft will be accepted, please contact Helen Andersen or Cheryl Bock for approval.
- Adding care instructions to your item (separate from the price tag, as that will be removed from the item at time of sale) is greatly appreciated by the customers. Those items tended to sell first.
- When pricing your items, don't undervalue your work. Your skill has value.... Don't be afraid to price it as such.
- Please use plastic containers, clear bedding bags, cardboard boxes or suitcases in which to place your guild boutique items for drop off with your **large seller #** label attached. **WE will not** accept grocery bags or garbage bags. This makes sorting the items after the show much easier and faster.

## GUILD BOUTIQUE PROCEDURES

- Each Seller must have a number. To get a seller number contact: **Helen Andersen** email: [boutique@saskatoonquiltersguild.com](mailto:boutique@saskatoonquiltersguild.com)
- Each Seller must **use the price tag form provided**. This can be found on the guild website.
- Sellers are to use **coloured paper** to distinguish their items from other sellers. This means all your price tags should be one colour, **NOT** a multiple of colours. (This **really** helps sorting your items and tags after the show, preventing placement of items in the wrong bag.) Make copies of the Guild Boutique Price Tag Form for pricing onto your coloured paper.
- Fill in your tags (see example below). Items are to be priced in increments of one dollar-e.g. \$1.00, \$16.00, \$50.00, etc. Items **cannot** be priced in multiples-e.g. "\$5.00 each or 3 for \$12.00."
- Make a copy of your inventory for your own records.
- Cut up the sheet and attach the price tag to the item **with a safety pin** (no tiny gold safety pins *please*).
- Any other information such as care instruction or your name/phone number must be on a separate tag.
- Please bring guild boutique items for drop off with a **large seller #** label attached on plastic containers, clear bedding bags, cardboard boxes or suitcases that have your seller number (Large) displayed on the container. **WE will not** accept grocery bags or garbage bags.
- Please label any display props with your seller # and name.
- 12% of your sales after credit card fees deducted, will be taken to rent the space for the booth.
- **DISCLAIMER:** The Saskatoon Quilters' Guild Inc. shall not be held responsible for any lost or stolen articles.
- **DROP OFF: Prairieland Park, Hall E, Thurs. October 23, 2025, between 7:30 am and 9:00 am** same
  - line-up as quilt drop off.
- **PICK UP: Prairieland Park, Hall E, Sat. October 25, 2025, between 6:30 and 7:30 pm.** Same line-up
  - as quilt pick -up with Guild Boutique. **Pick-Up Form must be in hand.** Pick-Up form will be emailed to each seller closer to the date of the show, but it can also be found on the website.
